AT HOME

Avoid Flooding

- Check your sump pump:
 - Is it functioning properly?
 - Is the drain clear?
 - Is the battery back-up working properly?
- Consider sandbagging areas around your home
 susceptible to flooding.
- Walk-out basements or window wells:
 - If either have drains, check that they are clear and free of debris.
 - Check drains regularly during rain.
 - Clean gutters.
 - Move cars away from flood prone areas.

Avoid Wind Damage

- Secure or move inside all outdoor furniture, play equipment, grills, potted plants, flags, etc.
- Move cars away from trees and utility poles.

Be Prepared

- Fill cars with gas.
- Get gas for generators/chainsaws, etc.
- Connect major appliances and electronics to
 surge protectors or should the power go out,
 unplug these items.
- Have a supply of water for drinking and hygiene (fill bathtubs, buckets or purchase).
- Check flashlights and have extra batteries.
 - Charge cell phones.

AT YOUR BUSINESS

Many of the above practices should also be applied to businesses however there are a few important things to consider as well.

- Back up files and move off-site.
- Establish an alternate means of communication with your employees/customers.

ABOVE ALL BE SAFE

- Stay away from downed wires.
- Turn around don't drown most cars can be swept away in 2' of water and as little as 6" of rushing water can sweep away a person.
